Safe Driving Program Under 21 and Alcohol Related Defensive Driving Course 8 Hour Class



This DDC 8 hour class is for drivers under the age of 21. These are drivers who are at high risk and were driving under the influence. Participants learn on-the-spot defensive driving technique, including state and local driving laws and regulations. They will learn practical lifesaving information which includes:

- Why young drivers often underestimate risk
- Techniques to maintain control in driving situations
- How to handle peer pressure
- How to stay cool with friends
- The consequences of driving while impaired

The purpose of this class is to educate you in the effects of alcohol, how it relates to driving, and the consequences of driving while impaired. It will also familiarize you with the DWI laws of North Carolina and the zero tolerance law for persons under the age of 21. It is our goal to help you realize the importance of not drinking and driving.

To qualify you must:

- Attend court on your specified court date
- Ask the Assistant District Attorney, Private Attorney, or Judge if your violation qualifies you for this course
- Attend the 8-hour course offered by GTCC

You are not eligible if:

- The Assistant District Attorney, Private Attorney, or Judge has not referred you
- You have paid your citation prior to your class

TO THE HIGH POINT CAMPUS

FROM DURHAM

Take I-40 West/85 South to the I-85 Split. Take I-85 south to Exit 118 (Business 85/29/70 South To High Point). Do not take the GTCC Jamestown Exit, continue on Business 85/29/70 South. Follow this to the High Point Exit (Greyhound, Hospital, High Point University Exit). Turn Right on Main Street. We will be between the 6th and 7th stoplight on the right.

FROM CHARLOTTE

Take Business 85/29/70 North to the High Point (Greyhound, Hospital, High Point University Exit). Turn Left on Main Street. We will be between the 6th and 7th stoplight on the right.

Take 68 South to the 311/Main Street. Turn Left on 311/Main Street. Follow 311/Main Street through the center of town. We are just past the Ilderton Dodge Dealership on the Left.

FROM ASHEBORO

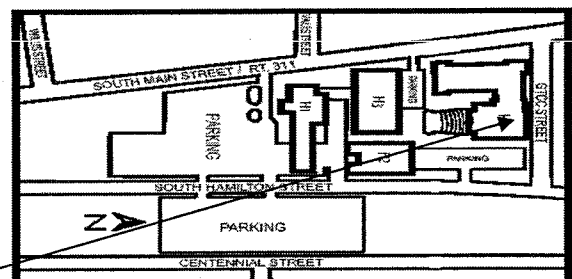
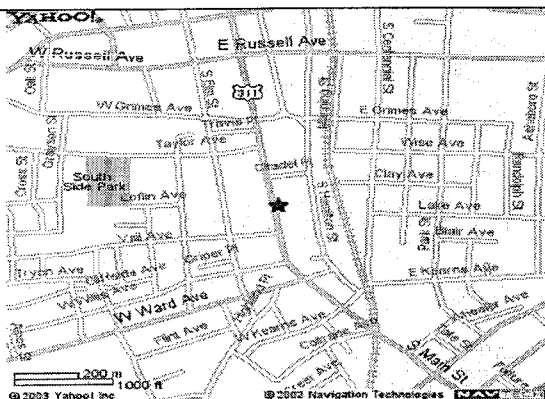
Take 220 north the I-85 South Exit. Take I-85 south to Exit 118 (Business 85/29/70 South To High Point). Do not take the GTCC Jamestown Exit, continue on Business 85/29/70 South. Follow this to the High Point Exit (Greyhound, Hospital, High Point University Exit). Turn Right on Main Street. We will be between the 6th and 7th stoplight on the right.

FROM WINSTON SALEM

Take I-40 east to the 311/Main Street Exit. Follow 311/Main Street through the center of town. We are just past the Ilderton Dodge Dealership on the Left.

FROM VIRGINIA 29N (DANVILLE AREA)

Take 29 South to I-40 west to the I-85 split in Greensboro. Take I-85 south to Exit 118 (Business 85/29/70 South To High Point). Do not take the GTCC Jamestown Exit, continue on Business 85/29/70 South. Follow this to the High Point Exit (Greyhound, Hospital, High Point University Exit). Turn Right on Main Street. We will be between the 6th and 7th stoplight on the right.
